## Assignment of Rights, Consent to Publish, & Employment Incentive Acknowledgment

KNOW ALL PERSONS BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT I, \_\_\_\_\_, do hereby give the Sarita and Claire Lucas Foundation full rights to publish my name, law school I am attending, and any photographs that I have provided.

I understand that by execution of this agreement, I am relinquishing my rights to any future compensation for reproduction, publication or use of the above information by the Sarita and Claire Lucas Foundation in its print or electronic correspondence, or on its website.

I understand this Agreement in no way obligates the Sarita and Claire Lucas Foundation to publish or use the above-described information.

I understand that the scholarship fund covers Bar Exam related costs: Application Fee, State Bar Exam Prep Course, computer Fee, PMBR course prep and excludes any costs associated with travel, lodging or meals. The Scholarship Fund will not be responsible for any **Late Registration fees**. Awards for Scholarships will not to exceed \$5,000.

### The Employment Incentive

The Employment Incentive is a monetary award for selected scholarship recipients. Scholarship award recipients who are awarded the Employment Incentive must secure employment as prosecutors. The scholarship awardees who are eligible for the Employment Incentive monetary award must apply to or accept employment from prosecuting agencies in Delaware, Massachusetts, Prince George's County, Maryland, or in the following counties of Pennsylvania: Philadelphia, Delaware, Bucks, Montgomery and Chester.

The Employment Incentive *continued*

In order to claim the Monetary award of \$5,000.00 qualifying awardees must notify the Sarita and Claire Wright Foundation, in writing, when they secure employment as a prosecutor. Awardees who are eligible for the Monetary Award must send written confirmation to the foundation at the end of the first year of employment as a prosecutor. Only written confirmation from the eligible prosecutor's offices in Delaware, Massachusetts, Prince George's County, Maryland, or in the following counties of Pennsylvania: Philadelphia, Delaware, Bucks, Montgomery and Chester will be accepted. The confirmation of eligible employment must indicate your date of hire. Failure to provide timely written notice to the Foundation, as required herein, may result in denial of the Employment Incentive monetary award. The Foundation has sole discretion to deny the award or extend eligibility for the Employment Incentive. The monetary award will be disbursed **at** the end of one year of full-time employment at one of the approved prosecution offices.

Scholarship awardees must immediately inform the Foundation, in writing, if they have applied for or accepted other employment.
